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Introduction to Oxford University Press

- Oxford University Press (OUP) has its origins in the information technology revolution in the 15th century.
- OUP is the oldest & largest university press in the world
- The first book printed in Oxford was Rufinus's *Expositio in symbolum apostolorum* in 1478. The first journal (still published) was *Brain* published in 1878.
- The first edition of the Oxford English Dictionary began publication in 1884
